

Dear Mayor Pro Tem Weatherman:

This letter is to inform you that the above-referenced compliance agreement for Radionuclides expired on March 5, 2010, because the compliance agreement has a three year termination date. Accordingly, your case is being forwarded to the Public Drinking Water Section for consideration of future action. A review of the program database on June 1, 2010, indicates there are still elevated levels of the contaminant in the drinking water. Please be aware that the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality may initiate additional enforcement action to address these ongoing compliance issues.
